

CHARITABLE GRANTS

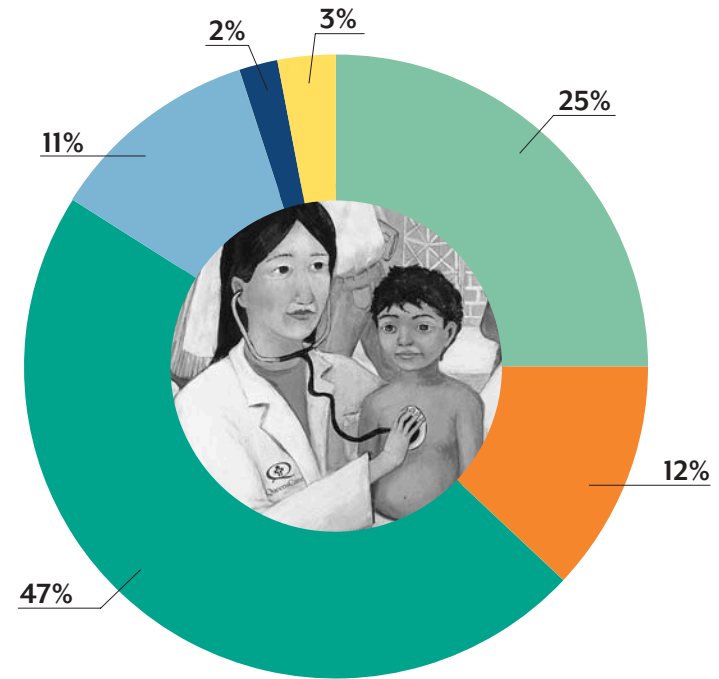
